Danish Open is open to all swimmers. Danish Open is a long course championship. Non-Danish swimmers participate on equal terms with Danish swimmers.

GENERAL PROCEDURES DANISH OPEN:

In conjunction with Danish Open 2019, the Danish Swimming Federation will also host the Danish Junior Championships (only Danish Junior swimmers can participate in this). For this set up, we have chosen to divide the morning sessions into two. Seeded heats will be swum first and will start at 09.30. The reminder of the heats will be swum in the second part of the session with starting time at 12.15.

The finals in the evening session will also be divided into two sessions. The session with the B-finals will start at 17.00 and the session with the A-finals will start at 18.30. Medal ceremony will take place in the 18.30 session.

PROCEDURES FOR 800 AND 1500 M FREESTYLE:

All individual races of 800 m and 1500 m will be held with a direct final. The fastest heat is placed in the evening session. Please note that these events will be a joint session for participants in both Danish Open and Danish Junior Championships.

PROCEDURES DANISH OPEN:

- ◆ All individual races of 50 m, 100 m and 200 m will be held with A- and B-final. The A-final consists of the eight fastest swimmers. The B-final consists of the next eight swimmers.
- ◆ All individual races of 400 m will be held with A-Final. The A-final consists of the eight fastest swimmers.
- ◆ If two or more swimmers have achieved the same time in the A- or B-final, their individual placement will be solved by drawing lots.

- ◆ If two or more swimmers have achieved the same place – e.g. last in B-final and first reserve – the individual placement will be solved by a swim off. The swim off will normally be held according to normal rules for swim off.
- ◆ Preliminary heats will be swum at 10 lanes. Finals A+B will be swum at 8 lanes. For 800m and 1500m freestyle the presumed fastest heat in the A final section will be swum at 8 lanes.



WITHDRAWALS PRELIMINARY HEATS

Withdrawals from **preliminary** heats have to be handed in, in writing, **latest at 19.30 the day before**. Withdrawals must be handed in at the Competition Office. You can also use the Wingrodan Sync program for which you will receive an ID and pass code.

WITHDRAWALS FINALS

Withdrawals for the finals must be handed in, in writing, latest 30 minutes after the result of the preliminary event has been published in the session in which the race has been swum.

FINAL CALL ROOM

15 minutes before the start of the heat in both preliminary heats and in the Finals each competitor shall appear in the final call room located close to the pool and stay there until a sign will be given to move on to the starting platform. Failing to appear in time in the final call room will result in a warning the first time and may result in exclusion from the final should the swimmer repeatedly fail to meet on time.

VICTORY CEREMONY

Will be held in the session with the A-finals. It will be evident from the timetable for the finals when the victory ceremonies will be placed. Competitors who after the request by the speaker will not appear personally at the final call room and join in the ceremony will not receive a medal.

ENTRY FEE:

Event fee is: DKK 110,00 or Euro 15,00 per swimmer per event.

The entry fee will not be returned under any circumstance. The entry fee has to be paid latest **Friday March 22, 2019**
